

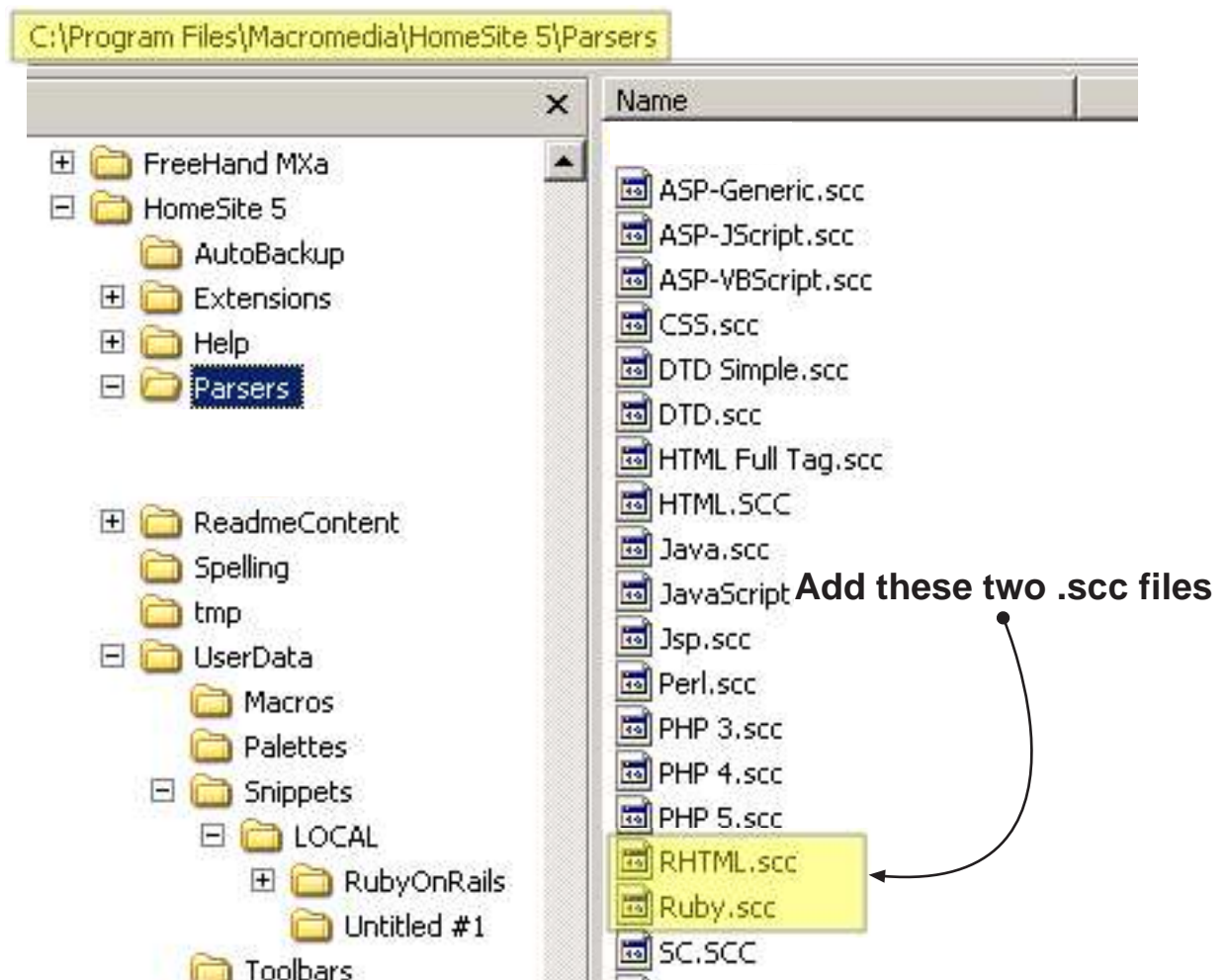


Railssite Installation Instructions

List of Files included with Railssite(other than this one)

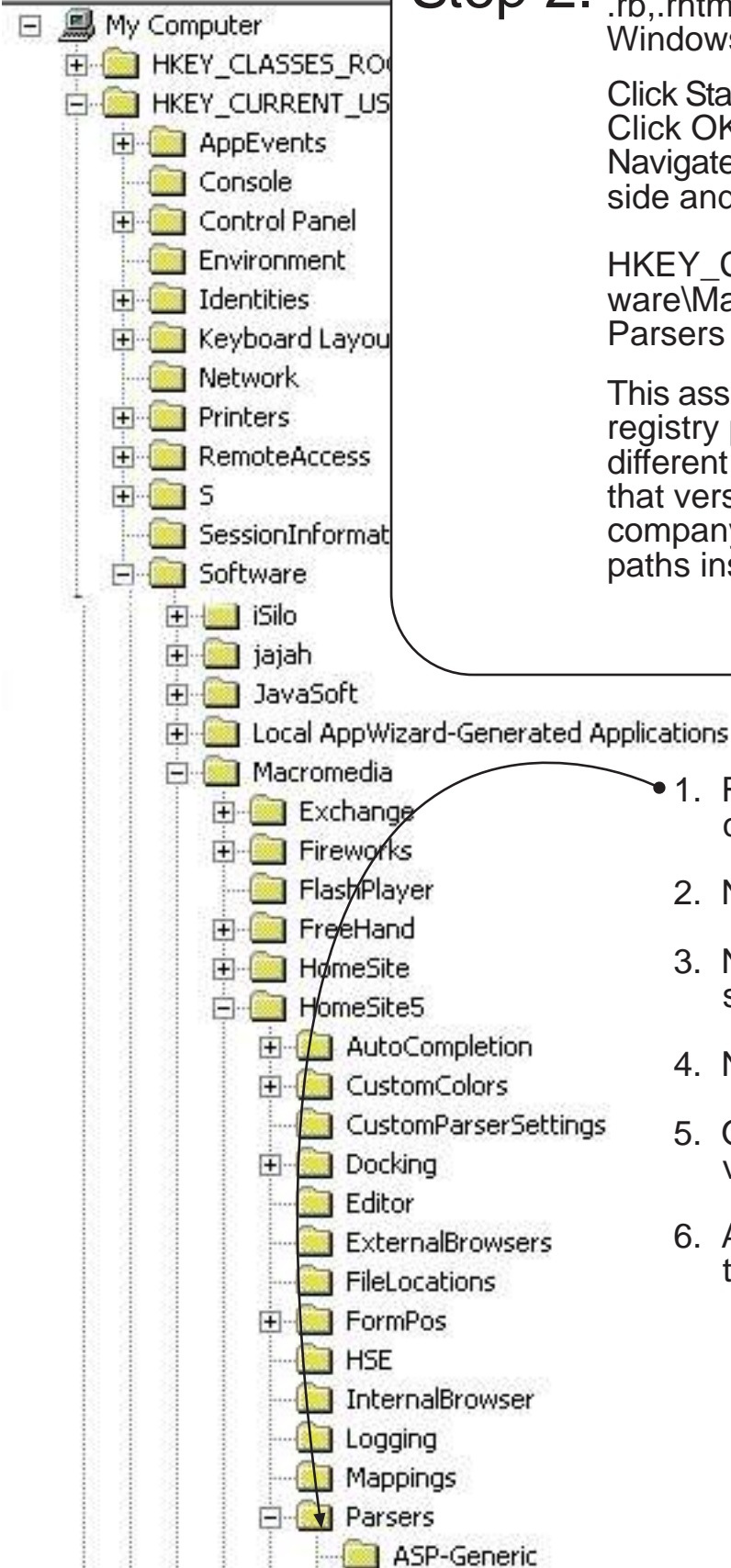
RHTML.scc
Ruby.scc
ProFontWindows.ttf
RubyOnRails(snippets folder)

- Step 1. Close down Homesite.**
Copy the files RHTML.scc and Ruby.scc to the Parsers subdirectory in your HomeSite install folder.
NOTE:
By default, the Parsers subdirectory can be found at:
C:\Program Files\Macromedia\HomeSite 5\Parsers\

Step 2. Adding extensions for .rb,.rhtml,.rjs,.yaml and .rxml. in the Windows Registry

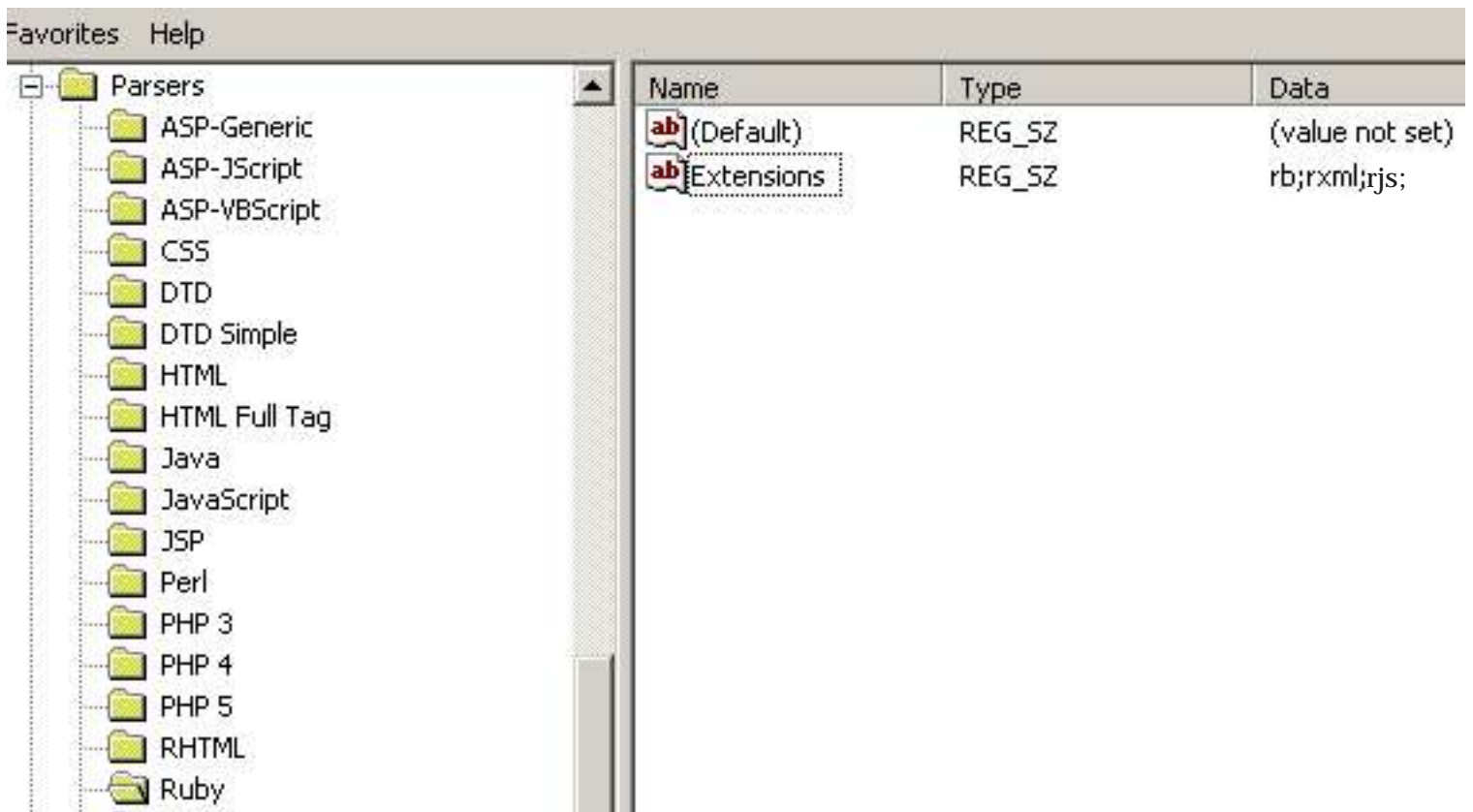
Click Start, Run, and type: regedit
Click OK
Navigate the tree on the left hand side and find

HKEY_CURRENT_USER\Software\Macromedia\HomeSite5\Parsers


This assumes HomeSite v5. The registry path may be slightly different for other versions. Note that versions 4.x use the company name "Allaire" in the paths instead of "Macromedia."

1. Right Click the Parsers Folder and click New -> Key
2. Name the key "**Ruby**"
3. Now Right click on the Ruby key and select New -> String Value
4. Name the string value "**Extensions**"
5. Ok, now right key on the new string value Extensions and select Modify
6. After selecting Modify enter this into the blank box **rb;rxml;rjs;**

Should look like this when your done with that step.

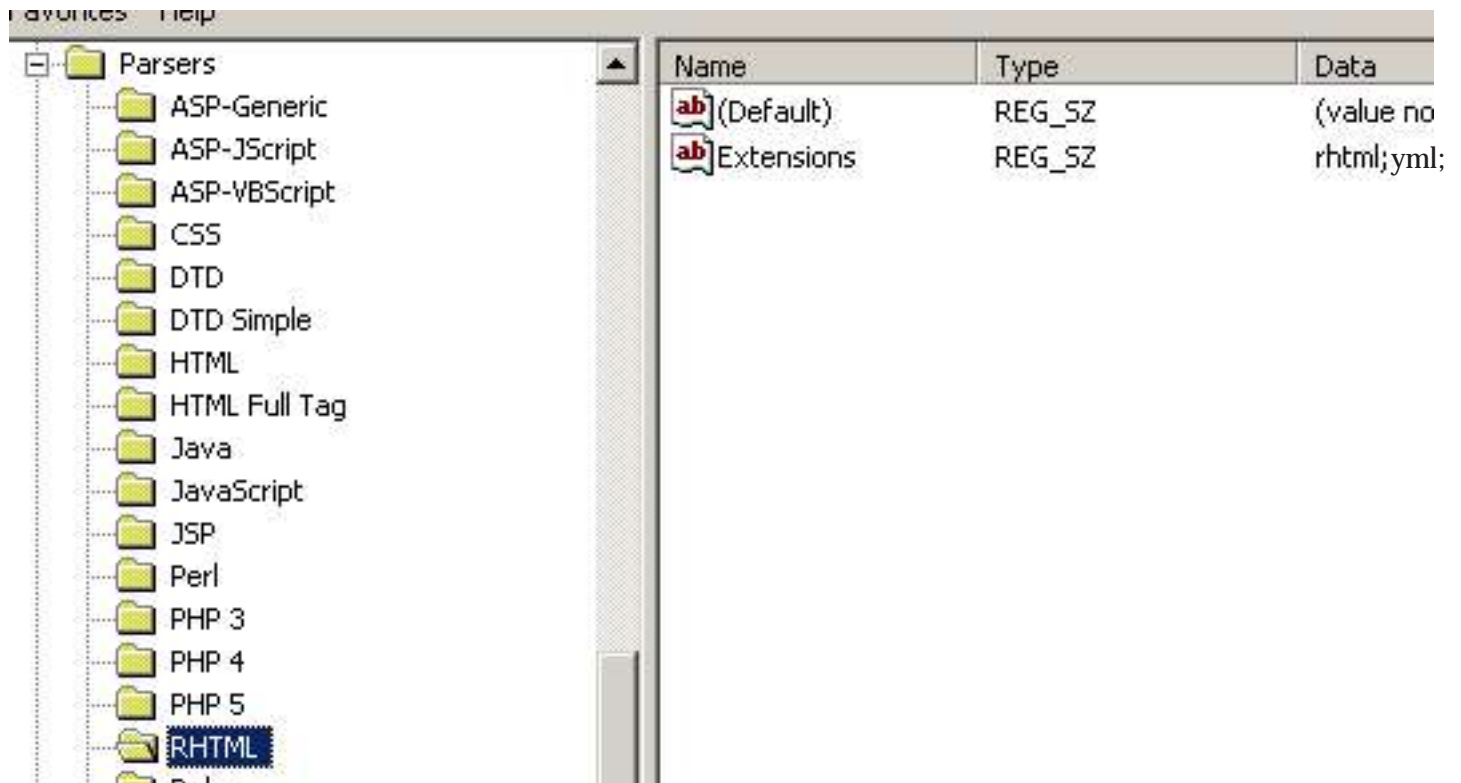


Now do it one more time for the RHTML extension.



1. Right Click the Parsers Folder and click New -> Key
2. Name the key "**RHTML**"
3. Now Right click on the RHTML key and select New -> String Value
4. Name the string value "**Extensions**"
5. Ok, now right key on the new string value Extensions and select Modify
6. After selecting Modify enter this into the blank box **rhtml;yml;**

Should look like this when your done with that step.



Step 3. Add new extensions inside of Homesite



Startup Homesite and select Options -> Settings

In the settings menu select File Settings -> Extension Manager

Add two new entries here for Ruby and RHTML
- make it look like this

Note: This settings screen looks different in Homesite 4.x.

Step 4. Check the install

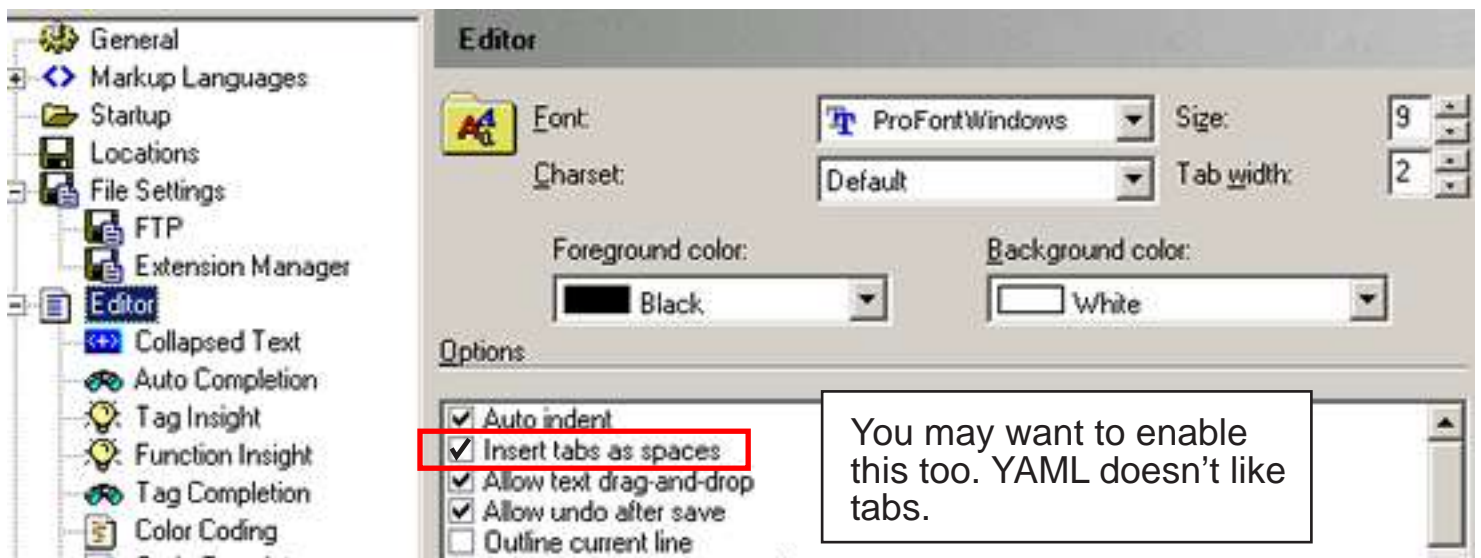
After the setting of the new extensions go down to the Color coding area and click on RHTML and then select Edit Scheme to see that every thing went ok with the install. Do the same with the Ruby scheme.



Step 5. Install ProFontWindow font

This is optional; however, this is a fantastic coders font and looks great when coding Ruby.

1. Copy ProFontWindows.ttf to C:\WINDOWS\FONT (of course this depends on which version of Windows you are using). You can also go through Control Panels -> Fonts -> File -> Install New Font to install the ProFontWindows.ttf.
2. In Homesite goto Options -> Settings. Go down to the Editor sections and set it to look like this. Don't forget the tab width for Ruby is 2.



Step 6. Install RubyOnRails Snippets

Copy the RubyOnRails folder to the directory C:\Program Files\Macromedia\HomeSite 5\UserData\Snippets\LOCAL

Again this will be different for Homesite 4.x
